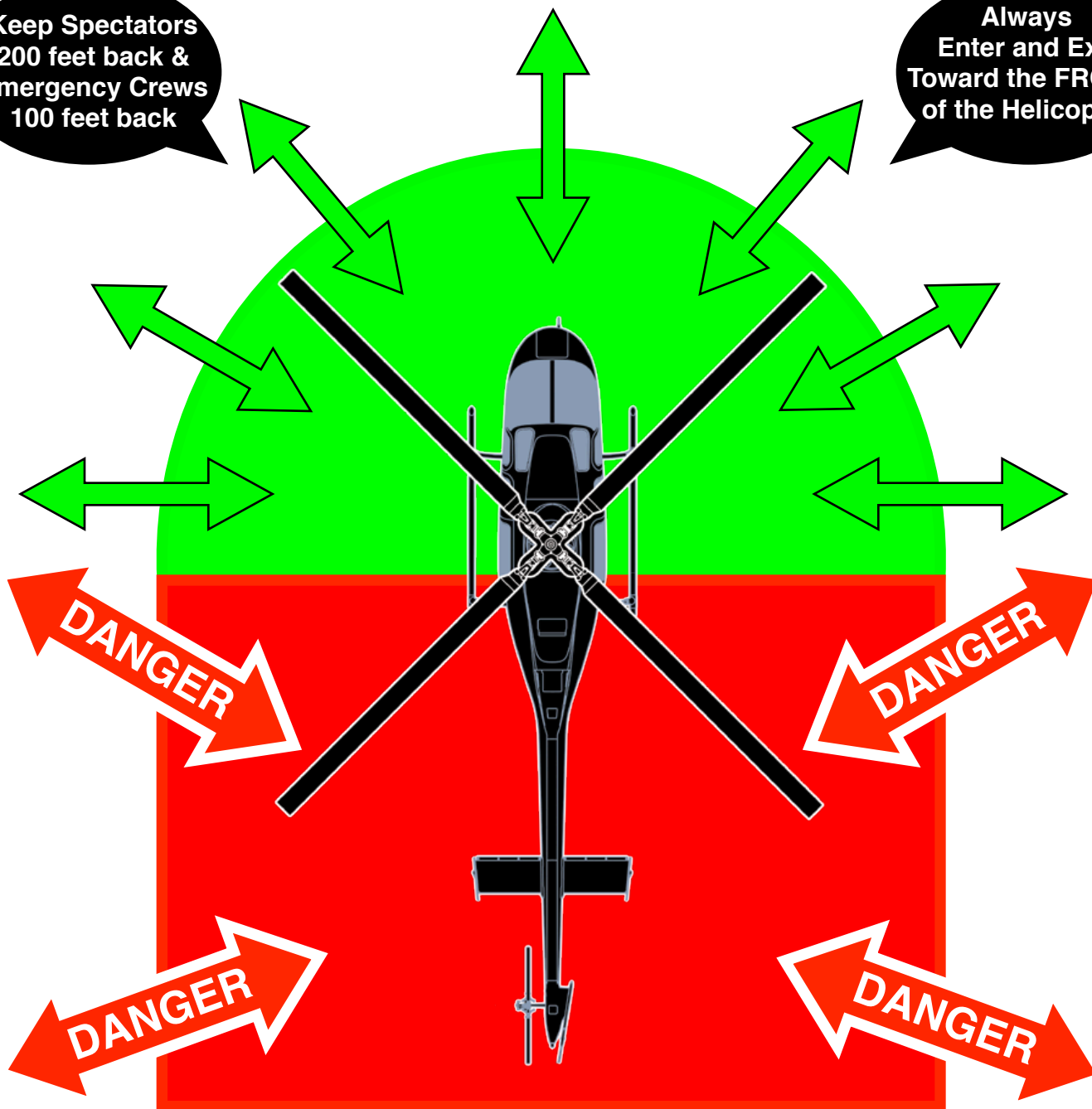


# APPROACHING & DEPARTING AIRCRAFT

**ALWAYS!**  
Approach and Depart the  
aircraft in View of the Pilot.

Keep Spectators  
200 feet back &  
Emergency Crews  
100 feet back

Always  
Enter and Exit  
Toward the FRONT  
of the Helicopter



**NEVER!**  
go beyond the Rear Passenger Door  
area indicated in red.

# LANDING ZONE PREPARATION

Radio Frequency  
1 Person Only!

Indicate the Wind  
Direction with a  
Traffic Cone,  
Strobe or Light

Use Traffic Cones,  
Strobes or Lights  
to Mark the  
Landing Zone

minimum 80 ft (25 meters)

TOUCHDOWN  
AREA

- Level Ground  
- No Wires  
- No Obstacles  
- No Loose Objects

into Wind and over
